NIGERIA GEEKS GIRLS COLLABORATIVE CAMP 2014: IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO ALL SELECTED PARTICIPANTS

1. All selected candidates are required to pick their **LETTERS OF INVITATION and PARENTAL CONSENT FORMS** at the Department of Computer Science, University of Ibadan between Monday 4th August and Thursday 7th August 2014 (10.00am – 2.00pm daily)
2. All selected Candidates **MUST** submit their **PARENTAL CONSENT FORM** before registration; failure to comply will lead to disqualification of such candidate
3. All selected candidates are expected to arrive at the Department of Computer Science on Monday 11, August 2014 by 9am **PROMPT. Lateness is seriously discouraged.** Interested parents/guardians and teachers are free to participate at the opening ceremony which will take place at Kola Daisi Hall, Department of Computer Science University of Ibadan from 11.30am to 1.00pm.
4. On arrival candidates are expected to fill a **PRE-PROGRAM** evaluation form
5. Campers who come with money in excess of five hundred naira (₦500) will have to keep the money at the custody of the Camp Finance Officer; which will be returned after the program or as needed by the candidate.
6. Please note that check-out and departure is Saturday 16, August, 2014. Parents should be pick up their ward(s) or child(ren) same day by 12.30pm. Parents are permitted to observe the final geek girls competition, award and closing ceremony same day from 9.30am to 12.00 pm
7. **ON-SITE** Campers (that is those expected to stay in the hostel) should come with their toiletries (sponge, tooth paste, tissue paper, toilet roll, sanitary pad, towel, tooth brush, detergent/bar soap etc), changeable wears, covering cloths etc. and provisions as needed.
8. Parents/guardians of **OFF-SITE** campers (that is, those that come from their homes daily) should endeavor to drop off their children by 8.30am and pick them up by 5.30 pm daily.
9. We encourage parents/guardians/teachers to provide their ward(s) or children with necessary materials that will aid full concentration and enable them benefit maximally from the program.
10. Breakfast, tea-break, lunch and dinner will be provided for on-site campers. Off-site campers will be provided tea-break and lunch only.
